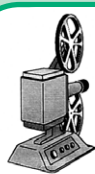

Apple Pie Contest: Sponsored by Paulus Orchard. PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED by Saturday, October 12. Forms available from Paulus Orchard, 522 Mount Airy Road, Dillsburg. All entries should be mailed to Carl Shearer, Blue Ribbon Apple Pie Contest, 60 Shearer Drive, Dillsburg PA 17019.

Rules: One Pie per Person

1. Open to any individual who is a Pennsylvania resident; one entry per person.
2. Entrants may NOT have won 1st place in this Blue Ribbon Apple Pie contest at any other fair in 2019.
3. Entry to be a pie must include at least 60% apples in the filling. It does not need to be a "traditional" two crusted apple pie and it can have a variety of fillings.
4. The entire pie must be submitted for judging in a disposable pan. (All pans, plates and dishes are considered to be disposable and will not be returned.)
5. The recipe for the pie and pie crust must be submitted with the entry. It should be printed on one side of 8 1/2" x 11" paper. The recipe must list all ingredients, quantities, and the preparation instructions. Entrant's name, address and phone number must be printed on the back side of all the pages. (All recipes and pies will become the property of the Fair or PA Farm Show and will not be returned.)
6. Refrigeration is not available at the Fair or PA Farm Show. Entries that require refrigeration after baking must indicate so in the recipe. Those entries will not be sold, auctioned or otherwise distributed for consumption after judging for food safety reasons.
7. Judging will be based on the following criteria:

Flavor	30 points
Filling: consistency, doneness, moistness & flavor	25 points
Crust: color, flavor, texture, doneness	20 points
Overall Appearance	15 points
Creativity	10 points
